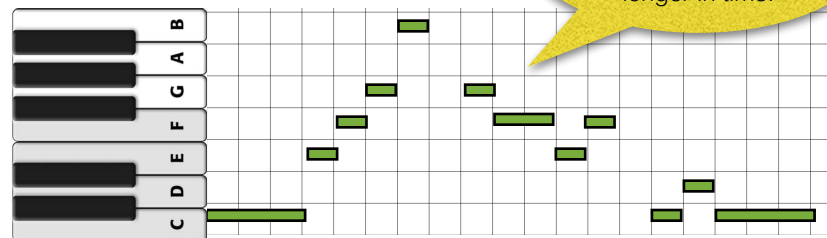


# Writing your name as music...

1. Improvise with your pattern, and record on your phone or computer once you're happy with it.
2. Listen to your recording and notate your name on the grid below by using blocks to show the order and relative length of notes you use. An example is given on the right.
3. The cypher only uses "white" notes, so you don't need to worry about any notes "in-between".

For example, a note that is longer from left to right would be held longer in time.
